Prerequisite:

- Studies at a Bavarian state university/college/university of the arts
- at least in the second semester
- Proven need (BAföG notice or means test)

Application process:

- Application at the beginning of the summer semester
- Application form online
- Documents to be submitted: Application form, certificate of enrolment, grade sheet, list of learning materials, proof of need
- University/college decides who is funded based on budget allocation and the number of applicants; a decision may have to be made based on academic performance
- Applicants are accepted, can purchase the learning materials and receive a refund from the university/college

What does the foundation offer?

- Funding for learning materials (books, tablets, notebooks, etc.) up to €500 per Bachelor's degree programme and per Master's degree programme
